Providing our collaborators and neighborhood residents free access to a wide array of equipment and tools including cutting edge 3D printers and computers, wood working equipment, assorted hand tools, air compressors, and more, including mentoring by and interaction with other members.

Oak Hill Makerspace Group

Weekly meetings featuring speakers and workshops on 3D printing, CNC routers, computer programming and coding, building skills, and more.

Youngstown-Warren Inventors Club

Monthly meetings to share ideas and resources for inventors and entrepreneurs.

Oak Hill Makerspace Programs & Projects:

3D Printing Classes

Ongoing series of classes on 3D printing taught by Makerspace members and open to the community.

CNC Router Build

Makerspace members are building a CNC (Computer Numerical Control) Router, a computer controlled cutting machine related to the hand held router used for cutting various hard materials, such as wood, composites, aluminum, steel, plastics, and foams.

Drone Program

The Makerspace Drone Program will involve a drone building project for Makerspace members as well as a fun and educational drone racing program for the community.

Oak Hill Lego League

Makerspace members are developing a Lego League in partnership with local schools which will teach young people the basics of building and robotic design and competition using Lego building blocks.

Makerspace Raspberry Pi Jam

This three-week course taught participants how to utilize the latest in microtechnology to develop unique projects from home automation to interactive art.
